The training is fun, we play games, solve problems, undertake challenges, discuss and debate topics and learn new skills!

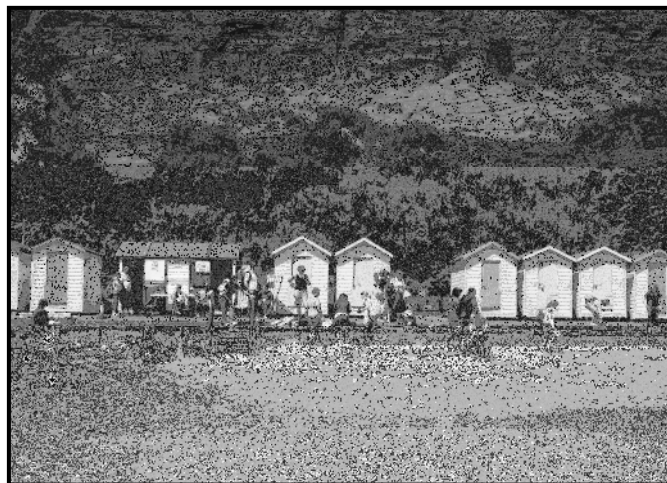
